

CATTLE SLAUGHTER CLASSES

Fact Sheet

RULES: as per Prize List and will be STRICTLY adhered to.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING: ALL CATTLE ENTERED INTO THE SHOW HAVE TO BE SLAUGHTERED. NO ANIMAL WILL BE PERMITTED TO MOVE ONTO A FARM OR FEEDLOT AFTER THE SHOW, REGARDLESS OF WEIGHT, SIZE OR SEX

NO CATTLE FROM FEEDLOTS WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER!!!

Vaccinations

NO VACCINATIONS are necessary. Please contact your local Veterinary department. **However, cattle to be sprayed with pyrethroid to prevent flies and the spread of disease. Cattle must be free from Lumpy Skin/Theileriosis/FMD.**

Cattle Weights

MINIMUM size is to be 400kgs. There is no maximum size, EXCEPT in the Milk tooth classes, which is 650kg. An overweight animal will be disqualified from the competition. Please note that the *quality* of the animal is being judged NOT the *quantity*!

Age: ONLY cattle with between milk and 4 permanent incisors (teeth) will be placed into the competition.

Please do not bring wild animals to the competition. Cattle must be dehorned.
NO bulls or cows will be allowed – you will be asked to remove them.

Please bring your own labour to look after your animals and also to assist with the judging and auctioneering.

PENNING: All cattle to be on the show grounds by 5pm on Sunday 19th of April 2026.

WEIGHING & MOUTHING: Tuesday 21st of April 2026 at 9:00am.

JUDGING: Wednesday 22nd of April 2026 at 9am.

SHOW SALE: Thursday 23rd of April 2026 at 4pm.
