**PRIZES** : At the discretion of the Committee.

**NOTE:** EXHIBITORS WILL ONLY BE PAID OUT FOR SECOND PRIZE IF THREE OR MORE ENTRIES IN THE CLASS AND THIRD PRIZE IF FIVE OR MORE ENTRIES IN THE CLASS.

**NB:** **ALL SALES OF LIVESTOCK ON THE SHOWGROUNDS MUST BE CONDUCTED THROUGH THE SOCIETY'S OFFICIAL AUCTIONEERS** (see General Rules and Regulations, Page 11).

Exhibitors are advised to study the General Rules and Regulations with regard to this section.

### **RULES**

1. All animals must be in their places ready for judging not later than 5:00pm on Monday 20th April 2026. The exhibitor or responsible representative must attend the penning of animals, provide feed and ensure they are watered. Animals will be permitted to be removed on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> April 2026 after 4:00pm. Judging will commence on Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> April 2026 at 9am.
2. The Judges are authorised to withhold prizes in all cases where lack of competition or standard of the exhibits do not warrant awards as stated in the Prize List.
3. Prizes will be to the value of amounts stated or vouchers at the discretion of the Society.
4. In the event of only one entry being received in a particular Breed, that entry will automatically be transferred to "Any Other Pure Breed". Classes will be combined if there are less than three entries in any one class. Second prize will only be awarded if there are three or more entries. Third prize will only be awarded if there are five or more entries, or at the discretion of the Judge.
5. There is no limit to the number of entries in each Class.

6. If a tooth is shot overnight, this automatically makes the animal eligible to be shown in the next up-grade of Class. Animals must be shown in the appropriate class.
7. **Attendants to hold Sheep and Goats while being judged and the owners are required to see that their exhibits are brought up punctually for judging. Please ensure attendants wear clean white coats or overalls during judging.**
8. The Committee shall have the power to refuse admission or to remove any exhibit found to be infected with parasites or disease or in any way objectionable. Such exhibit will be disqualified from competition and the owner shall be notified of the action taken.
9. All animals exhibited must be reproductive breeding animals and hereditarily sound (**CASTRATES ARE NOT ALLOWED**)
10. Animals bred by exhibitor will be considered for competition. Animal not bred by exhibitor will be accepted for display only.
11. Winners of all single classes are eligible for judging of the Champions. The second in each class must be prepared to enter the judging ring should the first placed in their own class be judged the Champion, in order to judge the Reserve Champion.
12. No advertising will be permitted until all judging in the breed classes has been completed.
13. Exhibitors who fail to participate will not be eligible for a refund.
14. Entries paid in respect of animals that are not accepted for the Show will be refunded in full.

## **VETERINARY INSPECTION OF SHEEP AND GOATS**

All Sheep and Goats must be free from all infections and contagious diseases and must be inoculated as required by the Veterinary Regulations in force at the time. Proof of such inoculations may be required at penning time. No animals will be allowed at the show without a valid Veterinary permit and Police clearance. Animal will only be allowed to be penned following inspection of required documents and confirmation as overall good health by BAS Committee representative and Veterinary Department representative.
